This OLR seeks an order concerning dissolution of the company Servista Technologies India Pvt.Ltd. (In Vol.Liqn.) with effect from the date of submission of this report, i.e. 31 October 2016.

2 The report is perused. The winding up is in pursuance of a special resolution passed by the shareholders in an extra ordinary general meeting. The voluntary liquidator of the company, M/s.Desai and Chinoy, Advocates and Solicitors, have submitted the final report of winding up in Form 157 pursuant to the provisions of Section 497(6) of the Companies Act, 1956 as also statement of accounts in Form 156. The Registrar of Companies, Pune has also submitted his No Objection Certificate confirming compliance by the company with the provisions of Sections 484 to 551 of

the Companies Act, 1956. The directors have also filed declaration of solvency with the Registrar of Companies in accordance with law. There are no objections from the Commissioner of Income-Tax. The Liquidator ^{has} ~~opined~~ *u* in his report that the affairs of the company do not appear to have been conducted in any manner prejudicial to the interest of the members of the public or of the company.

3 Prayer clause (a) of the report is accordingly allowed and the company Servista Technologies India Pvt.Ltd. (In Vol.Liqn.) is treated as dissolved with effect from 31 October 2016.
